Mobile Number on the spot using Net Banking/Debit/ Credit Card.	

Instructions for the participants/students:-

- a) The candidates are advised to read HSTES Admission Brochure 2021 (PROSPECTUS) carefully for eligibility conditions and other norms regarding admissions.
- b) For seeking admission the candidate should present himself in person before the admission committee (No representative will be entertained on behalf of candidate).
- c) If any candidates failed to pay the semester fee then he/she will have no right to claim for allotted seat. **The candidates need to pay the Admission/Semester Fee on the spot to reserve their seat.** Non-payment of Fee by the candidate will lead to cancellation of his/her seat and that seat will be considered vacant and will be offered to next waiting candidate (the candidates who have already paid the University Admission/Semester Fee earlier will be adjusted). **The mode of payment of fee will be through online using Debit/Credit Card/Net Banking and cash.**
