If two or more candidates secure identical marks (score) in the entrance test/ GATE, their relative merit will be determined by the following order of preference

- The percentage of marks obtained by them in the qualifying examination.
- Then marks obtained upto pre final year / semester examination.
- The candidate older in age will be preferred.

Preference shall be given to a candidate who has passed qualifying examination.

Note:-

- Merging of BC(A), BC(B), SC and DSC is applicable only when the eligible candidate is not available in anyone of sub category, irrespective of any admission list.
- If a candidate is not available in any of the reserved category, then those seats will be filled from AIC quota, irrespective of any admission list.

If a candidate listed in a particular admission list does not submit the fee upto the date as mentioned in above table , then he/she shall not be eligible till the end of above schedule.

**Cancellation of admission.:** In the event of a candidate withdrawing admission in Post Graduate programme upto 10.11.2020, the entire fee collected from applicant(s), after deducting processing fee (Rs. 1000/-) shall be refunded to the candidate. If admission of any applicant is cancelled after 10.11.2020, then their fee will also be refunded according to (i) If vacated seat is filled, full fee after deducting Rs. 1000/- will be refunded. (ii) Otherwise only caution money will be refunded.

Chairpersons are authorised to cancel admissions during admission process. After completing admission process, Chairpersons are required to send a list of all such candidates alongwith applications to Dean Academic Affairs office for further necessary action.
